TO BE READ AT MEETINGS AND POSTED:

1. The Mid-Winter Conference is scheduled for 13 & 14 January 2012. The event will be held at the Radisson Indy Airport hotel. Reservation form and banquet ticket order form is enclosed.
2. Tentative schedule: Friday 13 January 2012: Indiana Gaming Commission Seminar, open to all, from 1300 to 1600. Council of Administration at 1800. Saturday 14 January 2012: 0900 Business Session, 1315 Business Session, evening Voice of Democracy Banquet.
3. Annual members are reminded that their membership in the Veterans of Foreign Wars of the United States expires December 31, 2011, unless their 2012 dues are paid and reported to Department and National Headquarters. Every effort should be made to renew the membership of continuous members and also sign up new and reinstated members prior to January 1, 2012.
4. Public Law 103-308, designates 7 December as National Pearl Harbor Remembrance Day and requests the flag be flown at half-staff from sunrise to sunset to honor those individuals who lost their lives that day.
5. There have been two recent incidents of a party other than the VFW having access to and use of the VFW "state book" for use in mail solicitations. When these books are distributed the District Commanders are admonished that this information is for VFW business only and using or giving the information for any other reason is inappropriate and unacceptable. No matter how worthy you may deem the cause; if not directly related to VFW activity it is wrong to provide or use these names, addresses, and phone numbers.
6. Post Quartermasters and Trustees are asked to review By-Laws and Manual of Procedure as relates to Buddy Poppy. See BL Section 219 (Relief Fund), 704 (Relief Fund), 711(Buddy Poppy) & MOP Sections 219, 704, 711. Department Headquarters has received complaints of post(s) that improperly use the proceeds from Buddy Poppy campaigns. These funds are rightfully restricted as to how they may be used.
7. The State Bowling Tournament is limited to one weekend in 2012. The dates are 28 & 29 April. Questions to Mike Sims at 574.722.4703 or 574.721.1484.
8. Comrade Sims reminds all that Patriot Pen district winners must be in his hands not later than 15 December. See above #7 for contact information.

9. State Headquarters will close at noon on 22 December and reopen on 27 December to observe Christmas.
10. State Headquarters will be closed 30 December 2011 and reopen on 3 January 2012.
