Annual members are reminded that their membership in the Veterans of Foreign Wars of the United States expired December 31, 2011, unless their 2012 dues are paid and reported to Department and National Headquarters. Annual members with unpaid 2012 dues are not members in good standing and are ineligible to hold a post office, attend meetings or participate in VFW functions for members. Rights and privileges are restored upon receipt and processing of the 2012 dues payment.
3. Per Section 218, Manual of Procedure, the Post Trustee's Report of Audit for the quarter ending 31 December 2011, is due to State Headquarters not later than 31 January 2012.
4. Posts with canteen operations, rentals, bingo or charity gaming are cautioned to review operating procedures to insure that such operations are conducted according to all local, state, and federal laws; especially in the area of liquor, bingo, gaming, and sales taxes. The financial records of all such functions must be reported to the Post Membership each month. The Post Trustees must include the information on the Quarterly Audit after reviewing all such records.
