
GENERAL ORDERS # 5

November 1, 2011
2011-12 Series

TO BE READ AT MEETINGS AND POSTED:

1. Posts and Districts on a July 1 – June 30 fiscal year should file the proper federal (990) and state tax forms not later than 15 November 2011.
2. All posts and districts with a proper EIN are included in the Department of Indiana VFW group exemption for federal income tax under section 501(c) 19. The Group Exemption number to use is **0979**.
3. The Mid-Winter Conference has been rescheduled for 13 & 14 January 2012. The event will be held at the Radisson Indy Airport hotel. Reservation form and banquet ticket order form is enclosed.
4. Tentative schedule: Friday 13 January 2012: Indiana Gaming Commission Seminar, open to all, from 1300 to 1600. Council of Administration at 1800. Saturday 14 January 2012: 0900 Business Session, 1315 Business Session, evening Voice of Democracy Banquet.
5. State Headquarters will be closed on Friday, 11 November 2011, for Veterans Day.
6. Deadline for the next issue of Combat Veteran is 12 November 2011.
7. Annual members are reminded that their membership in the Veterans of Foreign Wars of the United States expires December 31, 2011, unless their 2012 dues are paid and reported to Department and National Headquarters. Every effort should be made to renew the membership of continuous members and also sign up new and reinstated members prior to January 1, 2012.
8. State Headquarters will be closed on Thursday 24 November and Friday 25 November to observe the Thanksgiving holiday.
9. Public Law 103-308, designates 7 December as National Pearl Harbor Remembrance Day and requests the flag be flown at half-staff from sunrise to sunset to honor those individuals who lost their lives that day.
10. Special Order No. 16, 29 September 2011, cancels Muncie Post No. 651, Muncie, Indiana charter and declares the post defunct.
11. Special Order No. 89, 25 October 2011, cancels Davis McCormick Post 1348, Fowler, Indiana charter and declares the post defunct.
12. Deadlines for holiday mail to troops down-range are approaching. The last recommended date for Parcel Post is 12 November. Parcel post is the most economical option as overseas military addresses ship at domestic mail prices. First class cards and letters should go by 10 December and Express Mail by 17 December in order to arrive by 25 December.
13. Several important documents are attached to these orders. Please review all.


