

4. Buddy Poppies should be ordered immediately to ensure delivery by Veterans Day.
5. Posts and Districts on a July 1 – June 30 fiscal year should file the proper federal (990) and state tax forms not later than 15 November 2011.
6. All posts and districts with a proper EIN are included in the Department of Indiana VFW group exemption for federal income tax under section 501(c) 19. The Group Exemption number to use is **0979**.
7. Mark your calendar and plan your work. The **1 November 2011 DEADLINE** for several VFW programs is rapidly approaching.
8. Deadline for the next issue of Combat Veteran is 12 November 2011.
9. VFW calendars are in the mail. Please remember that a substantial portion of your donation is returned to Indiana to operate our service department. Additional calendars are available from state HQ for a minimum \$8.00 donation.
10. Trustee audits for the quarter ending 30 September 2011 are due to state by October 31, 2011.
